Combined Mass at St Thomas's, Claughton, for both our Parishes, St Francis, Hill Chapel, and St Thomas's, to welcome Archbishop Maury Buendía, the Papal Nuncio to Great Britain, who will preside at the Mass and deliver the Homily. Fr Sony and Fr Andrew Coy, the Nuncio's Private Secretary will be concelebrating.

The Apostolic Nuncio represents the Holy Father to the Church in the UK. The role is equivalent to that of an ambassador representing the Holy See. The current Nuncio, Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendia was named by Pope Francis in April 2023.

The Apostolic Nuncio is the Pope's Ambassador to Great Britain and is coming to Lancaster as part of the celebration of the centenary of our Diocese in October. It is a great privilege for us to have the Pope's representative visit our Church. Having heard about its beauty and history he was keen to come and see it for himself. We very much look forward to welcoming him along with our fellow parishioners from Hill chapel to Claughton.

We are also delighted to have the school children joining us for a special musical contribution to the Mass.

Papal Curiosities

Who was really the model for the Vatican's statue of Saint Peter?

Inside the Vatican there is a seated statue, said to be a representation of St. Peter. But the head comes from the thirteenth century, the hands from the fourteenth, and the rest of the figure from the third century. Most Vatican officials believe the statue is a representation of a philosopher whose name is unknown.

What was the index Librorum Prohibitorum?

The Vatican Library also catalogs some 4,000 books that were listed in the Vatican's index of forbidden Books (Index Librorum Prohibitorum). The Index was created in 1557 by order of Pope Paul IV, whose reign most embodied the inquisition.

Quite a few of the index listing of forbidden books forever baffled some Church executives, such as Alexander Dumas's The Count of Monte Cristo and The Three Musketeers, Oliver Goldsmith's History of England, and Edward Gibbon's Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire. No reason was ever given for the anonymous bans, so one can only wonder why the index also included such innocuous documents as a 1664 treatise on the use of unguents for burns, an 1844 Swiss almanac, or a pamphlet on the museums of Italy.

Does Vatican law include the death penalty?

Even though Italy has long since abolished the death penalty, the Vatican still keeps the law on its books - a law that has not been imposed under papal regimes since the 1860s when Rome was under the direct rule of the popes. The last executions carried out under pontifical authority took place during the administration of Pope Pius IX, when two revolutionaries blew up a papal barracks and killed 25 of the pope's troops.. The duo, Giuseppe Monti, 33, and Gaetano Tognetti, 25, were beheaded on November 24, 1868. An Italian feature film on the incident, starring one of Italy's best-loved actors, Nino Manfredi, was made some years ago but received no international distribution.
